

Facilities of our venues

Wimbledon School of English is located in an Edwardian house with a beautiful large garden and stunning stained-glass windows. It is no more than a 5-minute walk from Wimbledon station (South Western trains and District line on the underground).

The building has been refurbished recently. It has a large classroom and numerous smaller classrooms which are airy and modern with good-quality sound systems and air-conditioning.

There is a coffee machine and water cooler. The school is only a short walking distance from a supermarket and high street with various food outlets (incl. Pret a Manger, Starbucks and Waitrose).

We still advise candidates to have a bottle of water (and some snacks) with them as the breaks between written tests are short.

This venue is used for both written and speaking tests.

Hillside Church Hall is located next door to Wimbledon School of English. The hall (Chapel) is on the ground floor as are the belongings room and bathrooms. It is no more than a 5-minute walk from Wimbledon station (South Western trains and District line on the underground).

The hall has a central heating system.

There are no refreshment outlets inside the building. However, a supermarket is only a minute walk from the hall. Also, high street with various food outlets (incl. Pret a Manger, Starbucks and Waitrose) are within a short walking distance.

We still advise candidates to have a bottle of water (and some snacks) with them as the breaks between written tests are short.

This venue is used for written tests only.

Tuition House exam rooms are located within a five-storey block of offices. We use rooms in our exam office (lower ground floor) as well as conference rooms on the ground floor. It is no more than a 2-minute walk from Wimbledon station (South Western trains and District line on the underground).

All exam rooms have air-conditioning. The conference rooms have a sound system with speakers in the ceiling.

There is a public water cooler (you need to use your own bottle). Otherwise, there are no other refreshment outlets inside the building. However, a supermarket is only a minute walk away as are various food outlets in the high street (incl. Pret a Manger, Starbucks and Waitrose).

We still advise candidates to have a bottle of water (and some snacks) with them as the breaks between written tests are short.

This venue is used for both written and speaking tests. This is our designated venue for all computer-based exams.
